Congressional Gold Medal to Honor "Four Little Girls" Passes Unanimously in House and Senate



On April 24, we were delighted that the U.S. House of Representatives unanimously passed H.R. 360, the resolution to bestow a Congressional Gold Medal to Addie Mae Collins, Denise McNair, Cynthia Wesley and Carole Robertson who lost their lives in the 16th Street Baptist Church bombing of 1963. We were honored to be joined by Dianne Braddock and Lisa McNair, sisters of Carole Robertson and Denise McNair, for this historic occasion.
