Deadline: June 1, 2024

Fall 2024 CBCF State Farm Communications Internship Program

Deadline: June 28, 2024

Fall 2024 CBCF Pathways to the C-Suite Internship Program

Deadline: Jun 28, 2024

This program partners **rising college seniors and recently graduated students** with some of the nation's top executives in the private sector to experience how public policy is influenced and developed at every level. Through this program, participants gain practical and meaningful work experience in a corporate setting and obtain first-hand experience working with organizations whose top priorities include diversity, employment, retention, and internship-to-employment opportunities. The program will take place in person from August 26th to December 13th, 2024. Interns will receive housing, and a \$4000 stipend (paid biweekly in increments of \$500) and are placed in a corporate sponsor's office. Interns interact with senior-level business leaders, explore multifaceted business challenges, and build skills to prepare them for careers in corporate America. Over the course of the 16-week internship, participants also take part in business networking, team-building events, and leadership development sessions to enhance their professional and leadership skills.
