2025 Congressional Art Competition Judging Guideline

Theme: "Picturing a Future for Our Historic District"

Each exhibit is judged separately. Each exhibit will be judged on its own merit in competition with regionally selected winners. The judges will use the judging criteria as listed and will give consideration to the degree to which standards are met. Each of the items has a maximum value as listed.

Judges will evaluate each exhibit on a point basis. The judges' decision is final.

Judging Process:

- 1. Independent judges give each art entry a score from 1-5 pts. per category.
- 2. An additional 5 points if entry meets guidelines.
- 3. Add points together.

Parts of the Overall Score:

Note: A perfect score for an art project is 20 points. The maximum score for each category is 5 pts. Plus 5 additional points if the entry meets the guidelines.

- 1. Creativity & Originality (1-5 pts available)
 - a. Is there originality?
 - b. Is there creativity?
- 2. Composition and Design (1-5 pts available)
 - a. Does the composition have a balance of color and design?
 - b. Does the composition reflect artistic ability?
- 3. Presentation & Skill (1-5 pts available)
 - a. Is the exhibit neat and attractive?
 - b. Did the composition require thought and skill?
