I am requesting funding for the Alabama School of Healthcare Sciences project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Alabama School of Healthcare Sciences, located at 918 Cedar Ave, Demopolis, AL 36735. This funding will allow for the buildout of healthcare simulation centers and its required software infrastructure, where students can practice patient care using high-fidelity simulation technology commonly found in nursing, and across medical training programs. Additionally, the funds will support a maternal and neonatal simulation suite, clinical patient care simulation lab, and a virtual reality healthcare simulation lab. This funding will also contribute to an outpatient clinical training suite, center for human anatomy and biomedical visualization, biomedical research laboratory, diagnostic imaging training laboratory, passenger vans to transport students to local healthcare centers, and multiple advanced science laboratories.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
