## **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

SEC. 2. OUTREACH AND REPORT ON ACCESS TO MENTAL
 HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
 CRISIS SERVICES UNDER GROUP HEALTH
 PLANS AND HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE.

5 (a) OUTREACH.—Not later than January 1, 2024, the Secretaries of Health and Human Services, Labor, 6 7 and the Treasury shall initiate a joint public outreach 8 campaign to inform individuals covered under a group 9 health plan or group or individual health insurance coverage (as such terms are defined in section 2791 of the 10 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg–91)) of Fed-11 eral requirements relating to the availability of, and limi-12 tations on the imposition of financial requirements or 13 treatment limitations for, benefits for mental health and 14 substance use disorder crisis services under such plans and 15 coverages. Such outreach shall emphasize the benefits of 16 such mental health and substance use disorder crisis serv-17 ices, including improved individual well-being, and seek to 18 19 reduce perceived stigma associated with accessing such mental health and substance use disorder crisis services. 2021 (b) REPORT.—Not later than January 1, 2024, the 22 Secretaries of Health and Human Services, Labor, and

23 the Treasury shall submit to Congress a joint report on—
24 (1) coverage of mental health and substance use
25 disorder crisis services under a group health plan or

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group or individual health insurance coverage, in cluding—

3 (A) which mental health and substance use
4 disorder services are covered as crisis services;
5 (B) the type of health care providers fur6 nishing such services; and

7 (C) common reimbursement approaches
8 and billing codes used with respect to such serv9 ices;

10 (2) barriers to individuals covered under a 11 group health plan or group or individual health in-12 surance coverage accessing mental health and sub-13 stance use disorder crisis services, including geo-14 graphic barriers and barriers caused by a limited 15 availability of such mental health and substance use 16 disorder crisis services in certain service areas; and 17 (3) issues relating to unexpected bills such indi-

18 viduals may receive after being furnished such serv-19 ices in certain service settings.

20 (c) FUNDING.—In addition to amounts otherwise
21 available for such purposes, there is appropriated
22 \$20,000,000, to remain available until expended, for pur23 poses of carrying out this section.
